With a booklet of resources and planning materials, members dove into their ideal audiences, set some marketing goals, and brainstormed content ideas and learned some key metrics to track to ensure their efforts are effective.

Oftentimes, we get stuck in a rut of not knowing what to post, or when to post, or "is this even working?!" Having a room full of ideas, and an expert to give insight seemed to help many attendees walk away with an action plan. Many attendees left the workshop with solid content ideas to enact be it with their email marketing or social media marketing.

Heidi prides herself in giving clients and other business owners insights into how to work smarter, not harder when it comes to content creation. For instance, creating blogs and longer-form content that can be repurposed into emails and social media content - all strategies that were discussed during the workshop. 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

Support Pasadena Woman Owned Businesses this Women's History Month!

Did you know there are more than 12.3 million woman-owned businesses across the nation, that's roughly 40% of ALL businesses in the country! The National Women's Business Council found that there are 114% MORE female entrepreneurs than there were 2 decades ago at the turn of the century. These businesses employ more than 10 million people nationwide!

However, there's still work to be done to make woman-owned businesses stand on equal footing to their male counterparts. Only 25% of woman-owned businesses seek financing, versus 33% of male business owners. Similarly, a 2018 study by the Kauffman Foundation found that women who seek financing pay higher interest rates than men, and when they do ask for financing, they seek out on average \$30,000 less than men.

As we support women entrepreneurs, let's be sure we're supporting them in more than just in March. Consider what you each do on a day-to-day basis to pave the way for the women and girls who have business aspirations in the future, versus celebrating the past. Let's consider how we're leaving OUR mark on history today and make sure that the challenges we have faced, are smashed for the next generation.

Finally, let's make sure to support local! When you support local businesses, and when you support woman-owned businesses, you are supporting someone's family and you're keeping your hard-earned dollars in the community that you live, work, and play in. Bonus, you're helping the girls behind us - who see women doing amazing things in the community, that they too can make a big difference. Here's a small sample of PBA members who are woman owned!
